Rocky Patel Sun Grown



Fantastic, full of flavor and smooth, perfectly smooth all the way through. Medium body, gets stronger in the final third but remains smooth and never sharp or bitter. Well aged, as usual for Patel.

Wicked flavor profile, a stronger medium with hard hitting notes of cedar and cream throughout. Smooth smoke with plenty of attraction, finished with the tiniest nub.

Alec Bradley Prensado (robusto)



Well aged tobacco, smooth and rich with a hearty smoke. The burn is even and slow, and even though it is a little mellow, it does present a fantastic aroma and taste of leathery notes, cedar, vanilla cream, and cocoa. You can smoke this right down to the tiniest nub and receive a pleasant, smooth draw every time.


